Question 05:

Approximately what percentage of SCE's commercial energy efficiency budget is spent on small commercial customers?

Response to Question 05:

SCE does not track its budget spent on small commercial customers. SCE determined that in 2016, approximately 12 percent of its commercial energy efficiency (EE) expenditures were spent on small commercial customers. This calculation, however, has several limitations:

- It is based on allocating Commercial sector *resource* program expenditures to small commercial customers, defined as those with demand less than 50 kW for purposes of EE
- Data is aggregated at a program level as SCE's program costs are unable to be easily broken down to a measure level.
- The calculation does not include any non-resource (e.g., Commercial Energy Advisor, Workforce Education & Training, etc.) program expenditures because they are only tracked by program and not by customer, thus they cannot be allocated to customer segments
- The calculation does not include Primary Lighting Program expenditures because the program does not track costs for individual customer installations.
