**Question 46a:**

Response to Data Request Question 28 states that the Business Plan presents the “IOUs’ overall approach to the DVC recommendations.”

a. Please explain in detail what this “approach” is and how it addresses the UC-Berkeley Don Vial Center Workforce Guidance Plan recommendations. Please identify by page number and paragraph where the SCE Business Plan presents this approach.

**Response to Question 46a:**

As stated in SCE’s Response to CEE DR Question 28, DVC Guidance Plan recommendations, along with the various evaluations, studies and reports that the IOUs have received, would be taken into consideration as a whole as part of the Rolling Portfolio Business Plan process. Rather than address individual recommendations on a case-by-case basis, the WE&T chapter of SCE’s Business Plan incorporates these inputs through a holistic approach. The holistic approach was discussed at WE&T Subcommittee meetings in 2016 and was addressed by SCE in the CAEECC issues tracker, where SCE stated “SCE in developing the BP has reviewed many recommendations and points of data not only from DVC, but from multiple consultants and program stakeholders over time,” and where appropriate, “SCE has reconfigured the program to incorporate various recommendations that improve the WE&T program in support of the EE portfolio.”[1]

Furthermore, the WE&T chapter of SCE’s Business Plan incorporated these recommendations through various goals, strategies and tactics. For example, WE&T Goal 1 to “Align, enhance, and deliver SCE’s WE&T programs through key partnerships and collaborations to effectively address market needs” outlines a high-level approach for evaluating and incorporating relevant studies, evaluations, and reports through comprehensive stakeholder engagement. Throughout the WE&T chapter of the Business Plan, there are citations where various evaluations, studies and reports are referenced, that informed the development of SCE’s strategies and tactics.
