Questions in the following four sections on PA statewide program proposals refer to the “Statewide Administration Approach” proposed jointly by PG&E, SCE, SoCalGas, and SDG&E in their whitepaper authored on January 17, 2017 (“Whitepaper”).

Statewide Governance Approach

37. What dispute resolution process (if any) would be employed within the governance structure to resolve disagreements between PAs?

SDG&E Response:

The details of a dispute resolution process are still under consideration but and the process will be in keeping with the Decision.¹ The IOUs shared an initial framing for a statewide governance structure in the jointly filed “Statewide Administrative Approach” as a part of the Business Plan application in January 2017. The IOUs continue to work collaboratively on the structure and anticipate having more details in place for statewide program implementation.
