**SUBJECT: APPLICATION OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (U338E) FOR APPROVAL OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY ROLLING PORTFOLIO BUSINESS PLAN AND RELATED MATTERS. CCE-DR01**

**QUESTION 32**

Does PG&E agree that it has the authority or discretion to support code enforcement efforts as part of its energy efficiency programs? If no, please explain.

**ANSWER 32**

PG&E objects to Question 32 as compound and vague. PG&E cannot respond to Question 32 as drafted because it is unclear what constitutes “support of code enforcement efforts.”

Notwithstanding and subject to these objections, PG&E responds as follows: PG&E is an electrical corporation as defined by Section 218 of the California Public Utilities Code, and is not charged with enforcing the California Building Standards Code. Local government agencies enforce the California Building Standards Code (Title 24) within their jurisdictions

PG&E complies with Public Utilities Code Section 399.4(b)(1), which allows it to provide rebates or incentives for an energy efficiency improvement or installation of energy efficient components or appliances in buildings only if the recipient of the rebate or incentive certifies that the improvement or installation has complied with any applicable permitting requirements, and if a contractor performed the installation or improvement, that the contractor holds the appropriate license for the work performed.

PG&E also complies with Public Utilities Code Section 399.4(b)(2), which makes its award of customer or contractor incentives for the purchase or installation of central air conditioning or heat pump projects contingent upon the recipient’s provision of proof of permit closure.
