STATEWIDE GOVERNANCE APPROACH

QUESTION 36

What administrative elements would the governance structure apply to?

ANSWER 36

The IOUs have identified a number of administrative elements, including: program budgets, program design (to the extent relevant), communication among implementers and PAs, contract and fiscal management, customer satisfaction, custom project support, program scope changes, and a dispute resolution process. These were identified as elements that would benefit from a statewide governance framework in the jointly filed “Statewide Administrative Approach” as a part of the Business Plan application in January 2017.

This document represents the joint IOUs’ initial thoughts on administrating statewide programs and is not intended to be a final framework for administration. The IOUs continue to work collaboratively on the structure and anticipate having more details in place for statewide program implementation.
