**CEE DATA REQUEST SET TWO (QUESTIONS 38 – 47)**

38. Response to CEE SDG&E Data Request 1 is vague and did not provide the information requested.

- a. In order to clarify your response, please respond with a “yes” or “no” to the following revised question: *Did SDG&E “develop pilot approaches collaboratively with stakeholders to incorporate workforce diversity and inclusion goals into their third-party contractor selection process” in response to Conclusion of Law 70 of D.12-11-015?*
- b. If the answer is yes, please describe what pilot approaches were developed collaboratively with stakeholders and provide any notices, memoranda, reports, studies or other documents that support this claim.

**SDG&E Response:**

**(a):** SDG&E objects to this request to the extent that it calls for a legal conclusion regarding the interpretation of D.12-11-05. SDG&E reaffirms its response to Question 1 in CEE’s initial data request. As stated previously, SDG&E works collaboratively with the vendor community to maintain its strong supplier diversity spending each year, exceeding the company goals in 2016 with 43% of all spending going to diverse business enterprises (DBE). Please see the Diverse Business Enterprises 2016 Annual Report and 2017 Annual Plan enclosed herewith as Exhibit A (see attached file Q38 2017-SDGE\_DBE\_Annual\_Report.pdf). Although each supplier’s--including each energy efficiency supplier’s--commitment to support SDG&E in achieving the company’s DBE goals is considered in the evaluation of competitive Requests for Proposal responses, and vendors are required to set and work towards achievement of DBE goals, SDG&E does not have any contract requirements or pilot approaches for workforce diversity, inclusion or goals specific to energy efficiency.
