Re: AB793 Energy Management Programs RFP Planned Release Notification

SDG&E intends to release **AB793 Energy Management Programs Request for Proposals (RFP)** in mid-August 2017, and will host a Bidder's Conference Webinar shortly thereafter. The following provides an overview of the AB793 program and the RFP.

On April 6, 2017, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) issued resolution E-4820 (Resolution), which approved, with certain modifications, the investor-owned utilities' (IOUs') 2016 advice letters in compliance with Assembly Bill (AB) 793.<sup>1</sup> The Resolution directed San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) to offer three energy efficiency programs, two directed at the residential sector and one at the non-residential sector. Specifically, the CPUC required the following:

- **Ordering Paragraph (OP) 1(a)**: The IOUs are required to “offer residential customers rebates for devices that utilize Advanced Meter Infrastructure data through a Home Area Network device or other similar medians such as the internet or Green Button Connect by the Fourth Quarter of 2017;”
- **OP 1(d)**: The IOUs are required to “launch residential pay-for-performance programs by the Fourth Quarter of 2017;”
- **OP 1(e)**: The IOUs are required to “launch small and medium business pay-for-performance programs by the Fourth Quarter of 2017;”

**Scope:**

This solicitation seeks proposals from qualified bidders for the residential and small and medium business sectors. SDG&E is asking the bidders to propose programs for Residential Home Area Network (HAN), Residential Pay for Performance Energy Management Technology (rEMT), and Small and Medium Business Pay for Performance Energy Management Technology (smbEMT) programs. This solicitation will be a “cafeteria” type solicitation meaning the bidder has the option of bidding on just one, two, or all three programs

**SDG&E will manage this event through PowerAdvocate's sourcing platform. Interested bidders should register now to access all future communications and the RFP upon its release.**

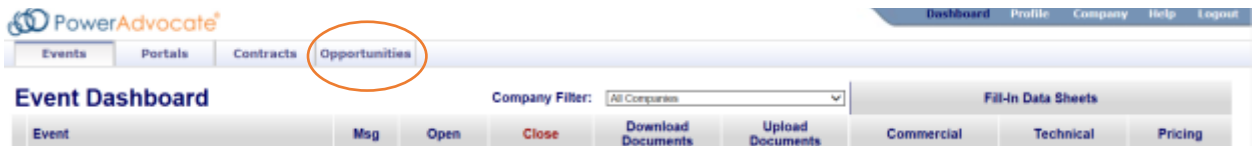
