SUBJECT: APPLICATION OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (U338E) FOR APPROVAL OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY ROLLING PORTFOLIO BUSINESS PLAN AND RELATED MATTERS. CCE-DR01

QUESTION 28

How will the 2018-2025 Energy Efficiency Rolling Portfolio Business Plan ensure that midstream and upstream programs do not subsidize energy efficiency equipment or measures that are installed by contractors that violate permit or code requirements?

ANSWER 28

CCE assumes that PG&E should not allow “contractors that violate permit and code requirements” to install equipment or measures that midstream and upstream programs introduce into the stream of commerce.

PG&E is an electrical corporation as defined by Section 218 of the California Public Utilities Code, and is not charged with enforcing the California Building Standards Code. Local government agencies enforce the California Building Standards Code (Title 24) within their jurisdictions.

PG&E is not a permit enforcement agency; thus, its Business Plan does not attempt to limit access to energy efficiency equipment or measures based on an entity’s permit status.
