Response to Question 011:

Through a comprehensive stakeholder engagement framework, previously established and coordinated by the Joint IOU WE&T Team, and engagement through the California Energy Efficiency Coordinating Committee (CAEEEC), SCE will continue to seek input to inform Implementation Plan approaches to EE intervention opportunities in disadvantaged communities. This stakeholder framework is made up of representatives including, but not limited to the CPUC, Labor Unions, the IOUs, California’s core education institutions, independent training providers, non-IOU Program Administrators, customer advocacy organizations, and when appropriate, end-use customers.
