**ANSWER 39**

The roles, responsibilities, tasks, length of appointment, and other expectations including time-commitments are all under consideration and not yet determined. However, the IOUs agree that these are important elements to consider and outline as we work toward a statewide administration framework. The IOUs shared an initial framing for a statewide governance structure in the jointly filed “Statewide Administrative Approach” as a part of the Business Plan application in January 2017. The IOUs continue to work collaboratively on the structure and anticipate having more details in place for statewide program implementation.
