- I made some formatting changes and made only the recommendations enumerated, while the rest of the heading sections are not. I hope this clarifies the structure of the document.
- I attached the spreadsheet with the updated data labels. I know you said you liked labels, but I suppose my quest for decluttering pushed that consideration out of my mind.
- I just completed the Orphaned DHW simulations. The LCC tool takes twice as long to run (5 hrs) and results in all of the results cells being #REF. It is a bit discouraging, and I recommend that we simply provide our recommendations as is and do not provide any simulation results attempting to include the orphaned DHW changes. The attachment reflects this. Perhaps we should also move #2 below the LCC results?
