In addition, when adding AB 793, include reference to the items in SCE’s AL on 793 implementation. • P.9 define retail, does it include more than material items, such as nail salons and fitness centers? Or is that part of misc.? • P.15 – the numbers are slightly different than p.9 (e.g., large on p.9 = 46% and on p.15 = 50%) • P.18 – what counts as “success” – savings? Participation levels? • Don’t see any goals for this sector until the metrics (p.21) – presume that will go in the summary that hasn’t been written yet? • P.21 - There are fewer barriers in the table than identified on p.6. If SCE is consolidating these barriers into problem statements, suggest including directly under the table of the barriers on p.7 to aid the reader in following SCE’s logic. • P.21 – presume the targets would be % increases vs. absolute numbers to provide the most useful information about progress. • P.22 – cite the studies that said this is an opportunity • P.23 – does the advanced lighting controls program require CALCTP trained workers? • Additional market characterization: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Add rent vs. own market characterization if available ○ Income characterization/zip code/other to provide insight into where the various commercial customers are ○ Geographic consideration (see PG&E’s BP p.12-13) • Suggest reorienting table so it can be printed larger as most folks will be printing these out.
