Question 012:

On pages 295 and 306, the SCE 2018-2025 Energy Efficiency Rolling Portfolio Business Plan states that the purpose of WE&T includes “gain skills that may lead to employment.” Please explain why the purpose is described as gaining skills “that may lead to employment” rather than stating that the purpose includes gaining skills “that lead to employment”?

Response to Question 012:

SCE uses the term “that may lead to employment” because the IOUs cannot guarantee that gaining such skills will automatically lead to employment nor can SCE guarantee employment. Employment opportunities resulting from WE&T offerings are a collateral benefit of participation. However, SCE cannot guarantee that participation in such education and training programs would "lead to employment" since employment decisions by companies depend on multiple factors.
