Dear John,

At the March 27, 2015 public meeting to discuss the notice of proposed rulemaking (NOPR) regarding amended efficiency standards for residential non-weatherized gas furnaces and mobile home furnaces the slide “Base Case Efficiency Distribution Chart” was presented. At that time we noted that the information for the years 2010 through 2014 was incorrect. To address this issue we are providing the following information on national annual shipments of non-condensing and condensing residential gas furnaces for 2010 through 2014.
