Subject: A.17-01-013 et al: Email ruling partially granting IBEW motion for extension of time

Dear parties to A.17-01-013 et al. (energy efficiency business plan applications):

This email ruling partially grants the February 14, 2017 motion for extension of time filed by the California State Labor Management Cooperation Committee for the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) and the National Electrical Contractors Association. The motion references the amended application by Southern California Edison Company (SCE) filed February 10, 2017 and requests an extension of time to protest/respond to all business plan filings on the new date for protests/responses to SCE's application.

This ruling partially grants the IBEW motion in order to allow additional time to respond to SCE's amended application. The deadline for protests/responses to all business plan proposals (from all program administrators including utilities, community choice aggregators, and existing and potential regional energy networks) will now be **Friday, March 3, 2017**.

Replies to protests/responses, which are only authorized to be filed by program administrators or potential program administrators who filed business plan proposals in January 2017, will be due no later than **Friday, March 10, 2017**.

I also note that IBEW's motion includes reference to its inability to search the PDF filing of San Diego Gas and Electric's (SDG&E's) business plan, a problem that Commission staff were unable to replicate. I request that SDG&E work with IBEW, and any other party requesting assistance, to ensure parties' opportunity to effectively review their business plan filing.

Finally, as a courtesy notice, parties should plan on **Thursday, March 16, 2017** for a prehearing conference (PHC) in this proceeding. A formal ruling noticing the PHC will be issued soon, but parties may consider the inclusion of this information in this email as a "save the date" notice for schedule planning purposes.

The Docket office shall formally file this email ruling.
