

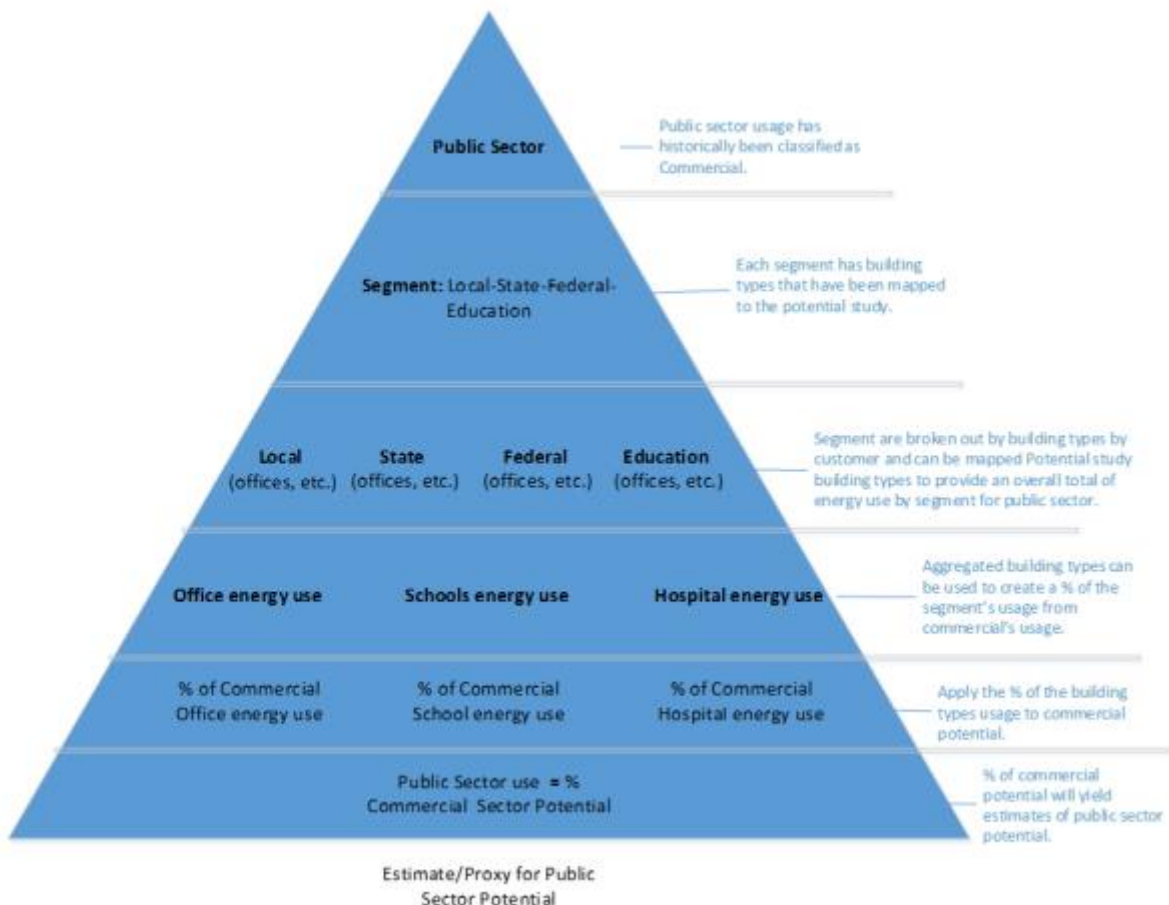

## Appendix I – Public Sector EE Potential Methodology

In order to begin developing the market potential for the Public Sector, SCE proposes the following calculation methodology. The Navigant Energy Efficiency Market Potential Study<sup>1</sup> developed for the CPUC to calculate technical, economic, and achievable potential sets each PA's overall EE goal. This study does not break out the potential by sector. Additionally, the proposed methodology below will only focus on building types and usage that have been included in the Potential study. As a result, SCE will set Public Sector targets based on additional factors, such as historical participation, as opposed to a market potential estimation.
