Program Description:

A regional workforce education and training infrastructure that supports underserved and Disadvantaged Workers (DAW) through 1) an organized, comprehensive regional workforce education and training partnerships and resource networks for disadvantaged workers and contractors at all skill levels; 2) includes entry-level workforce skills training infrastructure; and 3) a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise/Small Business Enterprise/Women Business Enterprise/Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (DBE/SBE/WBE/DVBE) contractor training program.

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Program Delivery and Customers Service Elements

Third Party Implementer will:

- Increase Southern California regional workforce and training infrastructure/partnerships comprising community-based training organizations, K–12 and higher educational institutions, apprenticeship programs, and workforce investment boards; and increase the quantity and skills of entry-level and incumbent workers in all levels of the demand-side management (DSM) and EE industry.
- Increase entry-level skills training and job opportunities for disadvantaged workers.
- Develop a regional energy management training program to increase the operational efficiencies of energy efficiency retrofit projects.
- Standardize local contracting policies and protocols into public bid/solicitation documents across the SoCalREN region to increase disadvantaged worker participation, and the capacity and participation of diverse, small, and disabled veteran–owned businesses in EE work.
- Collect, monitor, and report workforce and contracting outcomes.
